



GENERAL GREENFEE TERMS & CONDITIONS

Our contract and agreement with you

Our acceptance of your deposit or payment constitutes a binding contract between us and these conditions apply and you are deemed to have accepted these conditions. We reserve an absolute right without giving any reason to refuse any booking.

Check-in

All golfers are required to check-in prior to playing golf either at the main Reception desk or Professional Shop. All green fees and Guest green fees are due and payable prior to commencement of play.

Damages / misdemeanours

We reserve the right to invoice our guests for damage or negligent soiling caused to any parts of our premises or equipment; accidental or otherwise. Failing to inform us about damage to our property (including golf buggies, PowaKaddies and rental golf clubs) without delay or at the earliest opportunity may result in higher-than-expected maintenance or cleaning charges due to delayed intervention.

Dress Code

The London Golf Club aims to operate a contemporary and forward-thinking dress policy, commensurate with a modern day country club. The dress code must be adhered to throughout a guest's presence at the Club. Click to see [Dress Code](#)

Golf Buggies

If hiring golf buggies, the rules displayed within the buggy must be strictly observed. Failure to observe these rules may result in confiscation of the golf buggy without refund and/or in instant termination of your golf game.

Refund Policy

Green fees are non-refundable. Where a golfer is unable to honour a booking, the Club may at its sole discretion offer an alternative date and allow the booking to be rescheduled.

Cancellations and/or requests to reschedule a green fee booking can only be made in writing and can be done by emailing golf@londongolf.co.uk

Where the golf course is closed due to inclement weather or other good cause, a booking will be rescheduled and a 'rain cheque' issued. The Player will not have any claim against the Club beyond this.

Liability

The Club cannot accept any liability for any injuries caused to other persons by visiting players whilst on the Club's property, and all players acknowledge that they enter on to the golf course or into the Club's premises at their own risk. The London Golf Club strongly advises that all golfers hold personal liability insurance. The player shall indemnify the Club against any loss or claims arising out of the Players negligent conduct or act.

Code of Conduct

The London Golf Club places great emphasis on providing a pleasant and safe environment for its guests and staff. As such, we reserve the right to ask any guest who is abusive, threatening or offensive to our members, guests or staff to leave the premises immediately. Reasons for summary eviction include drunken behaviour, unreasonable demands, foul language, racist comments, suspected theft from the company or other guests, trespass in staff only areas, wilful avoidance of agreed charges, and suspected use of illegal substances – although this list is not exhaustive. All of our public areas are covered by CCTV and 24-hour Security.
